## 3 waves of Open Intellectual Property development:

1. Computer source code
  - 25 years of choice (GPL 1989)
  - Clear author – user distinction
2. Highly creative works
  - 12 years of choice (CC 2002)
  - Use quotes to separate authoring/using
3. Data
  - 3 years of choice (ODbL 2011)
  - Very little author – user distinction.

1. Contributors
2. End Users
3. End User Contributors (IMPORTANT!)
